To achieve a Certificate II in Community Services a total of 9 units must be completed including 5 core units and 4 elective units as listed below. The unit **CHCVOL001 Be an effective volunteer** requires students to participate in at least 20hrs of voluntary work in an organisation with a structured volunteer program.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING in SCHOOLS (VETiS) PROGRAM

The VETiS program is funded by the Queensland Government to give eligible students funding to complete one Certificate 1 or II level qualification while attending secondary school.

VETiS qualifications can be undertaken in years 10, 11 and 12, and can count towards the Queensland Certificate of Education.

Aurora Training Institute is a Pre-Qualified Supplier under this program for the delivery of this Certificate II qualification.

Every student that completes or discontinues a VET in Schools course must complete a Student Training and Employment Survey within 3 months.

FEES

There are no student fees applicable for this course.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to enrol in the VET in Schools program, you must:

- Currently enrolled in secondary school in either year 10, 11 or 12 and;
- Be a Queensland resident permanently residing in Queensland i.e. an Australia Citizen or permanent resident or a New Zealand citizen
- Not have previously completed or currently be enrolled in a Certificate III level qualification (or higher)
** Certificate III Qualifications completed at secondary school are not counted*
