COURSE DELIVERY

The Certificate III in Individual Support is delivered over 12 months. Trainers will deliver training on the job with regular workplace visits.

To achieve this qualification, the candidate will need to complete at least 120 hours of work placement. Aurora will help place participants in work environments to maximise best possible outcomes.
