### Do you enjoy helping people with disabilities?

Then this qualification may be right for you, as it is aimed at people seeking to gain higher level skills in the disability sector. Students will be exposed to actual workplace conditions and will have access to all the necessary resources and equipment needed to ensure competence can be achieved.

### **Entry Requirements**

To be eligible to complete the CHC43115 - Certificate IV in Disability under Higher Level Skills, individuals must hold Certificate III in Individual Support and be an existing worker in the Disability industry sector (this includes parents and unpaid carers of NDIS participants).

## **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible to enrol in the Higher Level Skills program, you must:

- ✓ Be aged 15 years or above and;
- ✓ Be no longer at school and;
- ✓ Be a Queensland resident permanently residing in Queensland i.e. an Australia Citizen or permanent resident or a New Zealand citizen
- ✓ Not have previously completed or currently be enrolled in a Certificate IV level qualification or higher (\*Certificate IV qualifications completed at secondary school are not counted)

## **Student Contribution Fee**
